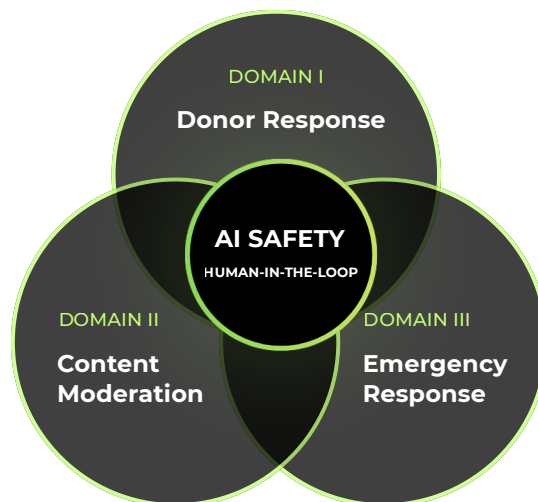


MEET MISSION CONTROL

DOMAIN I
